

# Redemption ~ is the “act of buying back.”

**A Penalty, A Price, A Payment, A Purchaser, A Purchased Person**

**Redemption is necessary when the object cannot make payment in any way.**

**The Fall:** When Adam sinned in the garden he died & became separated from God.

**The Law:** The school master taught (time and again) that Gods provision would include a payment in full.

**The Redeemer:** Left Glories, took a great stoop, humbled himself as a man to be our kinsman, fulfilled the Law, paid our full purchase price.

**The Redeemed:** Glory to God In The Highest, to the Name that is above every name ~ Our Lord Jesus Christ ~

**MAN’S NEED OF REDEMPTION. ~ Because Adam Sinned All Man Are Held Captive By Sin.**

**Romans 3:23** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

**Psalms 49:7** None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him:

**Job 33:24** Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.

**1 Corinthians 1:30** But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

**REDEMPTION BY BLOOD ~ Sin Demands Death ~ Blood Means Death Has Occurred**

**Ephesians 1:7** In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

**Acts 20:28** Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

**REDEMPTION BY POWER. ~ To Be Changed Forever/Never To Be In The Presence Of Sin Again!**

**Ephesians 1:14** Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

**Titus 2:14** Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

## **KINSMAN REDEMER. ~ God Is Eternal & Cannot Die/A Body Hast Thou Prepared**

**Leviticus 25:25** If thy brother be waxen poor, and hath sold away some of his possession, and if any of his kin come to redeem it, then shall he redeem that which his brother sold.

**Ruth 4:6** And the kinsman said, I cannot redeem it for myself, lest I mar mine own inheritance: redeem thou my right to thyself; for I cannot redeem it.

## **REDEMPTION FROM THE CURSE. ~ He Being Cursed Removed The Curse From Us**

**Galatians 3:13** Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

## **REDEEMED FROM ALL INIQUITY. ~ The Stain Of Sin Is Gone Forever/White As Snow**

**Titus 2:14** Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

**Ephesians 2:11** Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands;

## **REDEMPTION OF THE BODY. ~ We Will Have A Body Like Unto His Glorified Body**

**Romans 8:23** And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.

**1 Corinthians 6:20** For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

**Romans 6:13** Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

**Philippians 3:21** Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

## **CREATION REDEEMED. ~ Sin Will Never Corrupt Again/Forever & Forever Amen!**

**Ephesians 1:14** Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.
