II. God is Light

Passages to read: John 1:4-9, 3:19-21, 8:12; 1 John 1:5-7; Revelation 21:23-25

Description of light:

Natural: Radiates from a source outward; allows objects to be perceptible to sight;

To shine or make manifest;

Time was measured from sunset to sunset: the disappearing of each day's light.

Figurative: Purity, life, knowledge, salvation, testimony, favor

What is light characterized by?

- * Guides (Psalm 119:105)
- * The darkness makes it stand out (2 Peter 1:19)
